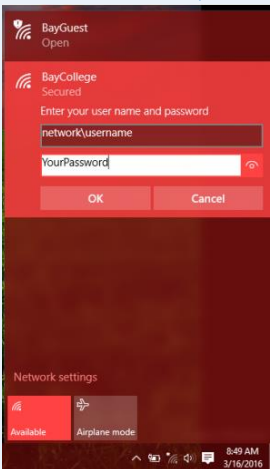


Windows PC

1. Click the network button on the right side of the taskbar (bottom right of screen)



2. Select **BayCollege** then click **Connect**
3. When prompted, use your Bay credentials to login. Correct format is:
network\your_username
Case sensitive, use backslash!



4. After you click Connect BayCollege should indicate you are connected

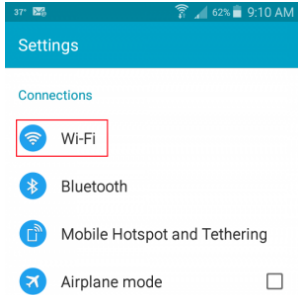

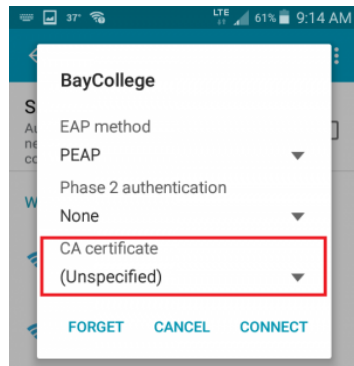
1. Navigate to your device **Settings > Wi-Fi**



2. Select **BayCollege**



3. A screen will appear with info about the network. Change the CA Certificate to **Do not validate**.



4. Configure settings as follows:

- Identity: network\username
- Anonymous Identity: leave blank
- Password: Your Bay College Password

5. BayCollege should display **Connected** and you should be connected to the internet

Some Android 11 phones such as the Pixel do not have the Do not validate option

To set up WiFi on your Android 11 Phone you must:

1. Connect to Bay College Guest network
2. On your internet browser, navigate to our **IT Support Wiki**

3. Download the certificate found here:

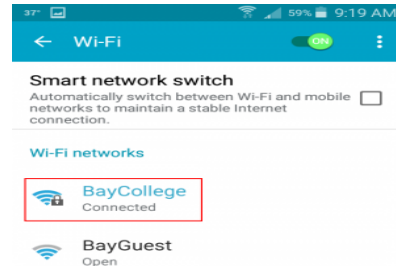

If it doesn't download, hold down on link, select "Download Link"

4. Go to Settings > Security > Install a certificate
- OR use the search bar and search for "Certificate"
5. When asked to install, a file explorer will open. Navigate to where file was downloaded select file ending in ".pem"

6. Name the file "BayWiFiCert"

7. Connect to the locked BayCollege WiFi

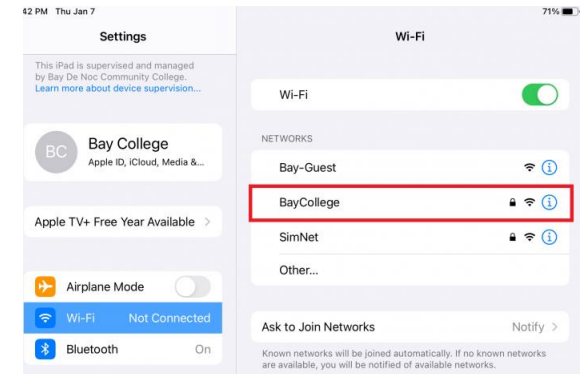


8. Configure settings as follows:

- Under **CA Certificate**: select "BayWiFiCert"
- Under "Online Certificate Status" Select "Request Certificate Status"
- Domain**: baycollege.edu
- Identity**: network\username
- Anonymous Identity**: *leave blank*
- Password**: your Bay College password.

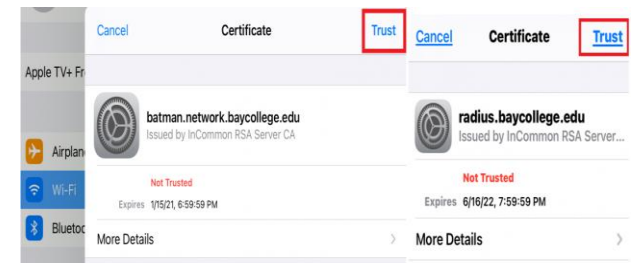

1. Navigate to Settings > WiFi > select BayCollege



2. When prompted, enter your **Bay username and password**, then press **join**.

3. If the **Certificate** window pops up, tap **Trust**.



4. Your WiFi settings should indicate you are connected.

Turn on **Auto-join** to automatically connect whenever you are on campus.
